THE TWO UPSET LEGENDS MARTINA HINGIS AND SANIA MIRZA TO REACH THE 2016 SEMIFINALS ... AND A YEAR LATER - AT JUST 19-YEARS-OLD - SHE STUNNED WORLD #2 ANGELIQUE KERBER ON THIS COURT TO REACH THE 2017 SINGLES QUARTERS.
